ENTRY FEES are \$16.00 first entry (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee) and \$16.00 each additional entry, same dog/same day (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee).

ONLINE ENTRIES: You may enter via AKC's ONLINE ENTRY SERVICES. Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your My AKC account to enter this event. **During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 100 runs/day via online entries 230 runs/day via paper entries.** If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

100% of entry fees will be refunded for any reason if a written (or email) request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date and time. After closing, refunds less fees will be given for bitches in season if written (or email) notification is received by the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial. Verification from a veterinarian may be required at the club's discretion.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. **Bitches in season are not allowed on the Trial grounds.**

ORDER OF CLASSES is SUBJECT TO CHANGE based on number of entries received. The final order will be included with the confirmation and judging scheduled issued after closing. Class order is expected to be:

FRI: FAST, STD, JWW (Exc level only; TALL to SMALL)
SAT: FAST, STD, JWW (all levels; SMALL to TALL)
SUN: JWW, STD, FAST (all levels; TALL to SMALL)

On SAT and SUN, in all classes:
Excellent, followed by Open, followed by Novice

JUDGING will begin at 4:00 PM on Friday, 8:30 AM on Saturday and 8:00 AM on Sunday. Judge's briefing and course walk-through will take place prior to judging. See below for building opening hours/availability.

RULES: A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es), and double-check your preliminary confirmation. **If you have questions about which class to enter, please contact the Trial Secretary before the closing date.**

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials (available at www.akc.org).

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registrable breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION: The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes.

8 inches	for dogs <u>11</u> inches and under at the withers	4" Preferred class
12 inches	for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	8" Preferred class
16 inches	for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	12" Preferred class

24 inches	for dogs over 22 inches at the withers	20" Preferred class
26 inches	at owner's option	none

HEIGHT CARDS: Please include a copy of your dog's height card (permanent or temporary) with your entry. ALL DOGS WITHOUT HEIGHT CARDS must be measured by the Judge.

CATALOG: \$7.00 Please pre-order catalogs by checking the box on the entry form. A very limited number will be available for purchase at the trial for \$10.00.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class. A stuffed dog toy (offered by FVKC) will be awarded to first place in each height division in each class. A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

All dogs earning their MACH or PAX titles at this trial will receive a MACH bar and ribbon or PAX bar! If you are close to earning an award, please let the trial secretary know so we are prepared to celebrate with you.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted in writing so that the Trial Secretary receives them by **6:00 PM MDT on Monday July 27, 2009**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via postal mail, or email to LNRose22@hotmail.com. If you do not receive a prompt acknowledgement of your move-up request, please contact the Trial Secretary to make sure that it was received. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups for Saturday and Sunday must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last class on Friday and Saturday.

VETERINARIAN (on call): Emergency Animal Clinic, 1914 S Reserve St., Missoula (406) 829-9300. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **The safety of dogs is of primary concern.** By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS: Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement attached, are not acceptable. Checks for entry fees will be deposited soon after the closing date. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee, except for bitches in season as specified on page 2. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: If the exhibitor provides an e-mail address, it is assumed that the exhibitor can receive e-mail with attachments from the Trial Secretary. A preliminary confirmation will be sent via email soon after your entry is received; please REVIEW IT CAREFULLY and notify the secretary of any necessary changes as soon as possible. Please make sure your spam blocker is set to accept messages from LNRose22@hotmail.com. A final confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent via email after the closing date. If an e-mail address is not provided, confirmation of entry will be sent by USPS after closing (no preliminary confirmations will be sent). If an exhibitor has not received a confirmation and schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

The **FIVE VALLEY KENNEL CLUB** and the **Trial Secretary** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds (and at your motel). We want to retain these facilities for future events.

SITE INFORMATION: Lolo Peak Arena, 16175 Hwy 12W, Lolo, MT. The trials will be held indoors on packed dirt. On Friday, the building will open for indoor exhibitor setups starting at 2:00 PM (the club will be setting up the ring in the arena prior to the building opening for exhibitors). The arena will be open to exhibitors at 7:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday. There is ample room for crating indoors, but please take only the space you need. The Trial Committee reserves the right to consolidate or move setups if necessary, to ensure crating space is available for all and access to the ring is maintained.

CONCESSIONS will be available Friday evening, and Saturday and Sunday for breakfast and lunch.

VENDORS: Due to limited indoor crating space, vendors will be limited indoors and will be close to, but not in, the general crating area. Vending spaces must be reserved in advance, do NOT have power, and are \$10 per day per spot. For more info and to reserve, contact Bett daythomp@msn.com.

CAMPING AT THE TRIAL SITE is by RESERVATION ONLY: There are limited RV/camp sites available. Reservations must be made in advance; contact Bett at daythomp@msn.com. RV/camping fees (payable at the trial) are \$10/night (no power, but water IS available). RVs/campers may arrive on Friday no earlier than 1:00 PM.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
