Sunday first dog on the line at 8:00 a.m. Walk through and judge's briefing will occur prior to 8:30 on Saturday & 8:00 on Sunday.

All confirmations will be sent via e-mail.

Running order: Saturday : Tall to Small, Elite, Open Novice; Sunday: Small to Tall, Elite, Open, Novice

Equipment List: Rubber surfaced dogwalk & A-frame; tunnels, hoops, jumps and weave poles.

Awards: 1st – 4th place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height. Chances class is pass/fail only, there are no placement ribbons. A qualifying ribbon will be awarded for each qualifying run. Awards must be claimed at the trial.

Trial Policies and Information

- Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler. Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only. The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.
- When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.
- **NOTE:** As of January 1st 2009, when entering the Skilled Category all dogs must jump 4" lower than their Proficient category standard division jump height. (Skilled jump height break is no longer optional).
- Please included your height card with your entry if you have one. If entering your dog in Skilled then there is no need for the dog to be measured or to include the height card.
- **NO AGGRESSIVE DOGS OR PEOPLE ARE ALLOWED.** This trial is to have fun with your dogs and enjoy the sport of agility.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Under no circumstance should a dog be tied to anything and left unattended. Remember to clean up after your dog so that we can use these grounds in the future.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry on the basis provided through NADAC rules & regulations. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC and/or ARRTI will not be allowed entry in the trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open for any reason beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- No refund of entry fees after the closing date except (1) for bitches in season (2) for dog or handler that suffers an injury or illness that prevents the dog from competing – such cases to be reviewed on a case by case basis by trial committee. The trial secretary must receive a written request for refund accompanied by written confirmation from veterinarian by May 1, 2009. Refunds will be less judging fees.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc. its member, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules & regulations of NADAC and any other rules & regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to person, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises including but not limited to the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals & people. Exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release A Rover Runs Through It agility club and NADAC including NADAC officers, directors, employees and members and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present & future loss, injury, damage claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. IMPORTANT: Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.
